SECTION 1: The Incident Room (Observation & Analysis)

CASE LOG 7A - Incident Summary

A woman named Reya Maan was found unconscious in her apartment. Her windows were locked from the inside. The door was latched.

On the table was a spilled glass of water, a half-burned note, and her phone — with only the flashlight turned on.

The last call made was at 2:03 AM to someone named "Dr. 5". Police arrived at 3:00 AM.

Q1: List 3 unusual elements in this scene that contradict a natural accident.

Q2: What might be the reason the flashlight was on and not the screen?

SECTION 2: Intelligence Pattern Drill

Below is a coded entry found in a suspect's notebook:

N31 - R17 - N35 - G13 - N39 - B9

Q3: Decode the pattern. What could these represent?

(Hint: Observe structure. One set repeats with increasing number.)

SECTION 3: Case Reconstruction (Custom detective logic)

CASE FILE: "The Vanishing at Terminal 4"

A man named Arman Shah, an AI ethics professor, disappears inside an airport terminal 10 minutes after check-in.

There's no footage of him leaving or entering the washroom. His boarding gate was C12. Only clues:

- His briefcase was found in Gate C16 (4 gates ahead)
- A security camera timestamp shows him in two places at 5:42 PM
- The only passenger who noticed him was a child, who said, "He changed shirts and then disappeared."

Q4: Based on above, what is the most likely mode of escape or deception used? Explain briefly.

SECTION 4: Moral Dilemma – Operative Test

You're tracking a high-value suspect. You discover they're going to attack a public location within 6 hours.

You trace them to a private hideout, but they are holding a hostage.

Your team has 2 snipers, but no confirmed shot on the target without risking the hostage.

Q5: What is your call? Choose one:

- A) Take the shot and risk the hostage
- B) Wait and track further, risk public attack
- C) Try psychological negotiation
- D) Create a diversion and storm the room
